WineBev Services Overview

WineBev Services is a social enterprise owned and operated by United Cerebral Palsy of the North Bay. WineBev Services employs adults with developmental disabilities who repackage wine and other products, assemble packaging (kitting), and work on-site at local wineries and other businesses.



- WineBev Services is a Bonded Wine Cellar (BWC) with Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Licenses 14 & 22.
- WineBev Services is a cost-effective business partner for wineries in Napa and Sonoma Counties.
- Skilled Production Workers operate machinery used to store, package, and ship wine to wholesale and retail distributors.
- Our modern 25,000 square foot warehouse is conveniently located in the Napa Valley Gateway Business Park and is fully accessible for all employees.
- Additional projects include kitting wine shippers, packaging polybags, sorting and bundling bulk products, custom labeling, and quality assurance testing and sorting.



Offsite Work Services

WineBev Services contracts with wineries and other manufacturers, much like any business that offers temporary production help. The main difference is that we supply a working Quality Assurance Supervisor who stays with a group of 3-4 very capable workers. The QAS is also trained to work with your project management team to ensure quality workmanship.

- All supervisors are safety trained, CPR Certified, First Aid Trained and Criminal Background Cleared.
- We can coordinate flexible shift hours, according to customer project needs.
- Pricing is contracted on an hourly basis.



All contracts are inclusive of WineBev Services covering all workers' compensation insurance, general liability insurance, employment taxes, withholding and administration of all payroll and related functions. WineBev Services has a proactive risk management program and makes safety a number one priority.

- WineBev Services offers career opportunities for employees with developmental disabilities in our Adult Day Program and our Community-Based Program.
- Our employees work full-time or part-time while participating in a variety of activities at WineBev Services and in the community.



- Program Leaders provide training in paid work, self-advocacy, community integration, social recreation, education, and self-care.
- Our employees earn market-rate wages while performing production tasks that include packaging, labeling, and shrink-wrapping.
- Health and wellness is promoted through work and recreation activities that encourage physical fitness and social interaction.
- Our employees with developmental disabilities are provided transportation to and from WineBev Services and into the community.
